## **\*\*PROJECT UPDATE – CONSTRUCTION HOURS\*\***

*We appreciate your cooperation while we continue to provide reliable power to Calgarians.*

### WHAT'S HAPPENING?

ENMAX Power Corporation is modifying existing electrical infrastructure along 12 Street SE and 17 Avenue SE to accommodate the City of Calgary's Green Line LRT project. This work includes the installation of steel pipes and casings for underground cables and burial of an overhead power line using a micro tunnel methodology. These utility modifications are required to ensure the alignment will be ready for future Green Line construction.

As of December 4, 2020, ENMAX completed the micro tunneling portion of work beneath the CP Railway tracks, east of 12 Street SE along the 17 Avenue SE corridor. The machinery required to perform this work may have produced noise, vibrations, and exhaust greater than typical construction machinery. A fuel-burning generator was used to power the device, and while producing smoke, presented no additional health risks to the area.

Remaining civil work involves the installation of two manholes either side of the CP Railway tracks and associated underground cables.

### WHEN?

**To complete construction activities related to the rail crossings, please note that crews are required to perform 24/7 operations starting December 16, 2020. This work will be intermittent until December 31, 2020.**

- **December 16 to December 24, 2020:** 24/7 operations until 5 p.m. on December 24
- **December 25, 2020:** no work
- **December 26 to December 31, 2020:** intermittent day and night work until 5 p.m. on December 31
- **January 1, 2021:** no work
- **January 2, 2021:** work resumes, to include cleanup and demobilization of site

### WHAT CAN I EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION?

#### **NOISE**

There may be an increase in noise and/or minor vibrations during the 24/7 work. Please be advised we comply with the City of Calgary's Community Standards Noise Bylaw and have obtained necessary permits from the City for work occurring outside of typical construction hours. We thank the residents of Ramsay / Inglewood for their patience and understanding during this time.

## VISUAL

Please expect the following equipment on-site:

- ENMAX vehicles and heavy equipment on-site (in proximity with CP railway tracks)
- Road plates for any vehicle crossings, where applicable
- Construction barricades and/or temporary safety fencing
- CP flaggers

**Remediation of boulevards and pathways will take place in Spring 2021 or earlier, pending weather conditions.**

Property access will be maintained throughout construction.
